Sealed informal bids will be received by the Guilford County School System until **2:00 pm, Tuesday February 14TH, 2023** at 501 W. Washington Street, Greensboro, North Carolina 27401 to furnish all materials and labor for installation of Owner furnished lighting equipment for the project **Ballfield Lighting Replacement for Ragsdale High School**. Bids must be submitted in person or by shipping carrier. Include the following notice on the outside of the envelope: "**Confidential: Bid for Ragsdale High School**". Emailed or faxed bids will not be accepted. Bids will be opened privately and a Bid Tabulation will be provided to all Bidders that submit a bid.

Plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available in electronic PDF format beginning Monday January 30, 2023 for inspection free of charge through a Dropbox link that will be furnished to qualified Bidders on written request. Email requests for the link to Admin@TriadEngMEP.com. Requests must include "**Request for Ragsdale High School Bid Documents Link**" in the subject line and the **Bidder's valid N.C. Contractor License number**. Requests for links received after **5:00 pm Thursday February 9** will not be acknowledged. All official Bid Documents and addenda will be posted to the linked folder. Bidders will be responsible for checking the linked folder for updates up to the Bid Date.

A brief description of work in the project follows: Demolish and replace the existing ballfield lighting and electrical distribution systems. Receive, inspect and unload owner furnished sports lighting system and sectional poles. Install new poles and lighting system, provide new electrical service and electrical distribution to new lighting system. All work under this contract is to be included in a Single Prime contract to the successful bidder.

A **mandatory prebid meeting** will be held at the site at **2:00 pm on Tuesday January 31, 2023**. Attendees shall sign-in at the Main Office to be directed to the meeting area. Attendance at this meeting is required as a prerequisite for submitting a bid for the work. Bids will not be accepted from contractors that were not represented at this meeting by an employee on their payroll staff.

Bidders must be properly licensed for the work in accordance with Section 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

A 5% Bid Bond and 100% Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds are required for this project. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 60 days.

E-Verify Requirements: This project requires the awarded vendor to comply with the requirements of E-Verify. (U.S. law requiring companies to employ only individuals who may legally work in the United States – either U.S. citizens, or foreign citizens who have the necessary authorization.)

Minority businesses are encouraged to submit bids for this project. The appropriate forms from the section entitled "Participation by Women and Minority Owned Businesses" must be submitted with each bid to show good faith efforts to obtain Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise participation.

The Board of Education awards public contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or handicapped condition as defined by North Carolina General Statutes, Section 168A-3.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids presented and to waive any informalities and irregularities.
