

Frequently Asked QuestionsGuilford County Schools Related Service RFPs and Contracts -2023-24

Nursing

1. What agencies do you currently use for Nursing?

A. It varies, some agencies return as renewals others are added based on student need. (ARO, Bayada, Maxim, Premier, Intellichoice and Thrive were used during the 2022-2023 School Year.)

2. What rate per hour do you require for nursing?

A. Nursing: LPN/RN \$45.00 CNA2: \$18.00- \$25.00

3. Do you provide travel reimbursement?

A. No, we ask that your proposed rate be all inclusive. In most cases for nursing the provider remains at one site.

4. How many nurses/FTEs do you anticipate needing for the 23/24 school year?

A. 35-45 nurses, it varies based on enrollment and need. We have some shared assignments.

5. How many students do you serve in the nursing program?

A. It varies. We begin serving students at age 3. Some will graduate this spring.

6. How many students require 1:1 care?

A. Currently 36 students

7. Does Guilford County schools provide County issued ID badges?

A. Yes, we require the nurse or CNA to provide a headshot in front of a white background

8. Is any professional development provided to agency nurses from Guilford County Schools?

A. No, the agency nurses are employees of their agency and therefore responsible for training and skill assessment. However, we do provide an initial orientation.

9. Are agency employees compensated for any orientation?

A. Yes

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- 10. Is there a need for Infant and Toddler services or only pre-k-12?
 - A. Pre- K-12 only. The infant toddler program is not part of the school system.
